About us

LimaQ is a non-profit organization dedicated to artistic self-management, one of the objectives is exchange experiences between students and professionals, providing a platform for dialogue to stimulate new ideas and possibilities in the artistic context. LimaQ seeks to promote cultural exchange between national and international artists in order to generate intercultural artistic projects. Within these lines of work, the LimaQ team manages the artist un residence program to create dialogues that connect different expressions with peruvian context.

Residency program

The LimaQ residency program welcomes artists and related; national and international during the 21-day period to develop research and preproduction projects related to Andean cosmovision, pre-Inca context and Lima as a point of syncretism. The objective of the program is to create an environment for cultural exchange, improve preproduction and investigation of artistic, educational, architectural projects, etc.

Location:

The residency is located in the historic district of Pueblo Libre in the city of Lima, 30 minutes from the Jorge Chávez International Airport (LIM). Pueblo Libre was the seat of government during the war and former hacienda of the liberators of Peru. Besides a great colonial and republican presence, the district houses valuable Inca and pre-Inca temples, as well as the two most important museums of archeology in the country.







Accommodation:

We have a large apartment located in a central area, 30 minutes from the airport, 10 minutes from the beach and 30 minutes from downtown Lima. The apartment has 3 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms, kitchen, living room, laundry and air. All areas are equipped with hot water, electricity and wifi services 24 hours a day.

Upon arrival at the residence, artists will be given all the necessary information to travel around the city, as well as a list of strategic cultural points to visit.

3 weeks (21 days up to 30 days)

Residency periods

August, September, October, November and December 2019

Residency fee

400 USD / period (Two instalments)

Fee covers:

- Transportation airport residence airport (scheduled time).
- Welcome session with peruvian dinner.
- Accommodation in shared or private rooms for the period of residence (21D / 20N).
- Weekly meetings and talk circles conducted by the residence coordinators in order to exchange information and ideas.
- Weekly talks with Peruvian archaeologists specialized in the subject and cultural walks through pre-Inca temples.
- Weekly workshops of pre-Inca and Inca ancestral techniques. Analysis of ancestral languages.
- If the resident requires, the organization will provide the space and diffusion for resident's workshops and / or open studio. *



- The organization is committed to provide a plan of dissemination and constant information in the stages of the residency program.
- At the end of the residency the organization could select 1 up to 3 pieces of successful projects for the annual LimaQ Residence.*
- Invitation letters and certificates of participation will be extended to selected artists.*
- If artists wants to produce, the organizers will be able to adapt a space previous evaluation. *

* Upon request and coordination with the organization.

Obligations of the resident:

- The resident commits to develop the proposed project in the application form within the term of the residency program.
- Residents must have the ability to adapt to a new cultural context. All participating residents must be self-sufficient and independent to carry out their project or research.
- Ability to communicate in Spanish or English.
- The residents should cost their air tickets, meals, transportation and other personal expenses.

- The resident can offer an Open studio or workshop during their stay prior coordination. (They can be both alternatives)
- During the period of residence, artists are prohibited from bringing contraband, flammable materials, explosives and other dangerous objects. They must comply with the rules that regulate the use of the sites, space and facilities.
- The participants will facilitate records that they make during the residency to be included in publications, digital editions, web page and other means of dissemination of the activities.
