

Shoah Film Collection

In 2005, Agricola de Cologne received the **MOSAICA Award** given by **YORK University Toronto** (Canada) for his Internet based multi-media project „Family Portrait“ – spotlighting the Partnoy Family as a typical example for the Jewish diaspora, escaping from economical disaster and pogroms from Eastern Europe, finding shelter finally in Argentina, where the family, however, became victim of the persecutions of the military juntas - http://www.yorku.ca/mosaica/family_portrait/index.html

Launched on 27 January 2010, the International Holocaust Memorial Day (commemorating the Liberation of the Concentration Camp Auschwitz 1945), **SFC – Shoah Film Collection** is representing a worldwide unique initiative by the Cologne based media artist and curator Agricola de Cologne addressed to two different target audiences, the young generations of audio-visual artists to deal with the collective trauma caused by the NAZI totalitarianism – particularly the Holocaust – by using new technologies and approaches in order to keep vivid the memory of the Holocaust by sensitizing people via art, and on the other hand the future generations to be sensitized.

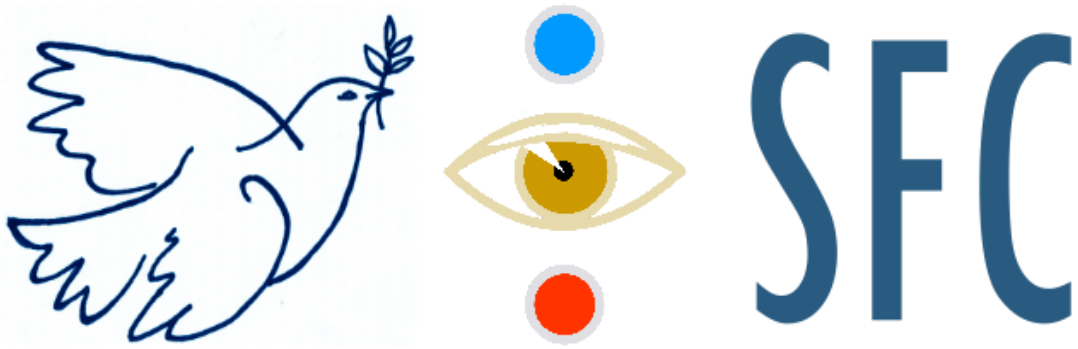
Following the open call each year on 27 January, artists and filmmakers from 27 countries participate contributing to the collection meanwhile 110 art films – documentaries, videoart and experimental films.

After a selection had been presented in Russia, Poland and Romania already in 2011, based on these experiences Agricola de Cologne created in 2012 a special event format, entitled: „AVMCI - A Virtual Memorial – Commemorative Interventions“ in order to present Shoah Film Collection to a wider audience, aimed to place the collection of films into the context of audience related interventions, like a symposium, lectures, exhibitions, performances of different kind, workshops, discussions, artists talks and much more, intending to activate the audience, as well as the artists.



The pilot project was realized in Riga/Latvia as „A Virtual Memorial Riga 2012“ <http://riga2012.a-virtual-memorial.org> between 1 and 30 June 2012 under the Patronage of the European Parliament, a collaboration with Riga Ghetto and Latvian Holocaust Museum, Culture and Arts Project NOASS Riga and artvideoKOELN. The next manifestations followed 2012 in Phnom Penh

and Warsaw, 2013 in Vilnius and Warsaw, 2014 in Milan (Italy), Jaffa (Tel-Aviv), Timisoara (Romania) and Moscow (Russia), und 2016 in Los Angeles (USA).



Shoah Film Collection

Shoah Film Collection became in 2012 the fundament of a new project context, entitled: „CTF – Collective Trauma Film Collections“- dealing with collective trauma and totalitarianism worldwide. On occasion of the manifestation „A Virtual Memorial Phnom Penh 2012“ - a 2nd film collection was launched, entitled: „**Cambodia 1975-1979**“, consisting of documentaries by young Cambodian film makers about the Cambodian genocide – a cooperation with the Royal University of Phnom Penh and the German-Cambodian Cultural Center MetaHouse Phnom Penh. In 2013, the next film collection was initiated dealing with the military dictatorships in Latin America, 2015 the next collection: „Never More! Hiroshima-Fukushima“ was added, dealing with the nuclear dangers for mankind, and most recently in 2016, the film collection „Refugee!“ ,including 40 art films, initiated in 2015 on occasion of the international refugee crisis.

SFC _ Shoah Film Collection, as well as CTF – Collective Trauma Film Collections are no finished, but ongoing projects expanding continuously regarding new perceptions, aspects and video works. Another kind of commemorative project is addressed to another sense, the hearing, entitled:

„soundCOLLECTIVE – collective trauma, identity and sonic art“ – <http://soc.newmediafest.org>
Soundart is a kind of art expression orientating itself on sound and noise, instead of musical compositions.

As a reaction on the uprising political Right Wing movements worldwide, especially in Europe, also in connection with the international refugee crisis, Agricola de Cologne initiated 2015 also the exhibition project, entitled: „**self~imaging – artists show face against Intolerance, Racism, Xenophobia and Anti-Semitism**“- <http://self.engad.org/2016/> featuring artists self-portraits executed in different artistic media. The afore mentioned projects of CTF_ Collective Trauma Film Collections, including Shoah Film Collection and the soundart memorial „soundCOLLECTIVE – collective trauma, identity and sonic art“ - represent a corporate part, generating a multi-dimensional media art experience.

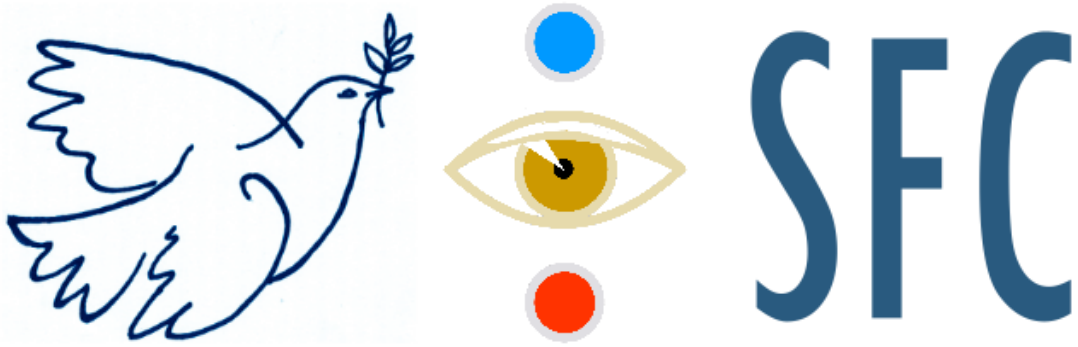
This project was premiered in February 2016 in Shillong, the capital of the Indian state Meghalaya and later in April/May in Los Angeles/USA.

Different Presentation Formats

In this way, the manifestation of Shoah Film Collection has different presentation formats – a) standing alone as “**A Virtual Memorial – Commemorative Interventions**”, b) standing alone as **d/i/light – Darkness Into Light Festival** and alternatively c) incorporated in the project context : **self~imaging – artists show face against Intolerance, Racism, Xenophobia and Anti-Semitism**

Presentation & Funding

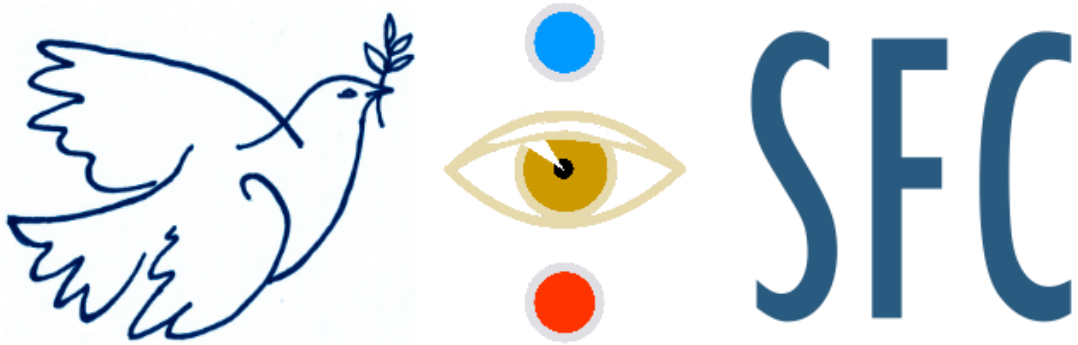
Shoah Film Collection is initiated, developed and curated by **Wilfried Agricola de Cologne**, operated by **artvideoKOELN**, who is the partner for any SFC manifestation, and hosted by **A Virtual Memorial Foundation @ The New Museum of Networked Art (N>MONA)**.

While the ongoing project development is generally requiring considerable funding sources and copyright issues usually generate fees (screening, hiring etc), in agreement with the curator and the participating artists and copyright holders, artvideoKOELN has the privilege to offer all interested cultural institutions and organizations the exhibition of Shoah Film Collection (screenings and installations) and the share of information **free of charge**. Beyond this contribution of extraordinary immaterial and material value, the entire local organization and its funding is up to the institutional partner.

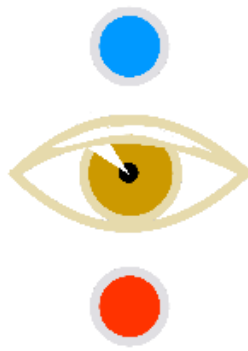

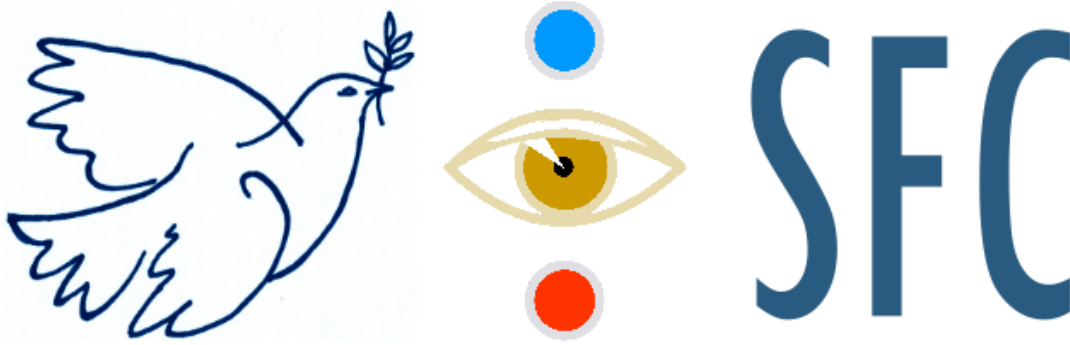

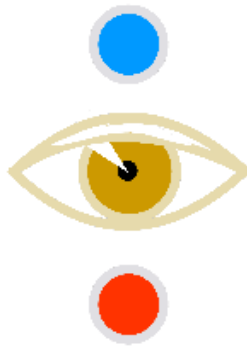
