

FSS – foundation screening series 2024/2025 – are dedicated to the 25th anniversary of the foundation of The New Museum of Networked Art – 01.01.2000 – 01.01.2025 – and the recent foundation process of "Agricola de Cologne Foundation for the Arts" operating "The New Museum of Networked Art" from 2025 on.

The programs at Alphabet Art Centre would like to support the project during the foundation procedure 2024/2025.

While the **Anthropocene** (actually only proposed as a new epoch of geologic time, following the Holocene) is an officially not yet definitely defined period of time during which human activities are thought to have had a significant impact on the global environment, regarded as having begun sometime between twelve thousand years ago, with the spread of agriculture, and two hundred years ago, with the advent of industrialization, as a topic of the media art context of The Anthropocene Project, the term is going far beyond marking the contradictory relationship between (the volatile transitory

character of) human nature and (sustainable) nature, the significant human impact on ecosystems, including the human-caused climate change, biodiversity loss etc.

Curated by Wilfried Agricola de Cologne, The New Museum of Networked Art realizing the Anthropocene Project as a new media art context in an exchange between virtual and physical space, physical and virtual exhibitions, and screenings, was inviting artists using moving images/digital video and the non-visual sound (sound art) as medium of art to submit digital art works dealing with the (positive and negative) human impact.

Exhibiting The Anthropocene Project is the invitation to the visitor/viewer of art to dive deeply to the bottom of one's soul via sensual experiences on different visual and non-visual levels transcending the boundaries of conventional ideas of art.

The 1st exhibition/screening program and the PDF catalog highlighting the individual video titles of the program to be screened is released as an extension of the coming general PDF outlining the concept and programming.
